THICK PROXIMITY CARD

KT–STD–2 is a 125 kHz passive transponder. It is compatible with proximity identifier readers and thus can be used in the alarm systems based on the <code>INTEGRA</code> control panels as well as in the <code>ACCO</code> access control systems. It allows the system users to take advantage of the access control functionality, and enables the administrator to identify individual users, record their attendance and working hours, etc.

The device comes in the form of proximity card the size of a standard payment card (85 x 55 mm, thickness 2 mm). Hence, you can carry it e.g. in your wallet, which diminishes the risk of it being accidentally lost. At its shorter side, the card has a hole that can be used, for example, to suspend the transponder from a lanyard or attach it to keychain. You can also place KT–STD–2 into the $\bf OP-KT-1$ holder for better protection against mechanical damage. Additional holes are also provided in the holder so that the transponder can be suspended from a lanyard.



Additionally, you can place an imprint on the card (text, photo, etc.) to facilitate its identification.
